**BUCK ANNOUNCES TRUSTEE TRAINING COURSES FOR 2008**

Since 6 April 2006, all trustees, whether new or experienced, have a statutory duty, within six months of appointment, to demonstrate that they have a knowledge and understanding of the laws relating to trusts and pensions, the principles of funding and investment, and the documents particular to their scheme. Buck has developed a range of training courses and bespoke training units, all designed with current legislation in mind.

The Practical Trustee training course is ideal for new trustees (even before appointment), or for seasoned trustees looking for a 'refresher'. The Investment Trustee training course builds on the Practical Trustee training course and provides essential knowledge to delegates on setting and maintaining investment policy. The practical emphasis again runs throughout the day, with a strong emphasis on workshops and discussion groups. **Investment Trustee training courses for 2008 will run in London on 26 February, 28 October and 2 December; and in Edinburgh on 7 May.**

Buck also offers scheme-specific training units for both defined contribution and defined benefit schemes. Every individual is given the opportunity to identify their own training needs, and the training is tailored specifically around what each trustee tells us they want.
